

GUIDANCE UPDATE FOR SENIORS (10-8-09)

COLLEGE APPLICATIONS

Now is the time, seniors. You should be narrowing your list of potential colleges and completing applications now. If you have not taken the time to see me regarding your individual circumstances and questions, you should do so. I remind you again that you are responsible for knowing deadlines. I can be a resource for you in determining the deadlines that apply to your situation, but ultimately you must meet them.

SPEAKING OF DEADLINES

December 1 is a deadline for many college/university scholarship opportunities and specific programs. For example, Ohio University's regular application deadline is February 1, 2010, but the application deadline for the Honors Tutorial College at Ohio University is December 1, 2009. Ohio State's regular application deadline is February 1, 2010, but December 1, 2009 is the deadline for full consideration for scholarships. There are earlier deadlines in some cases. Ohio Northern University's deadline for application for their pharmacy program is November 1, 2009. Some early decision/early admission deadlines are November 1, 2009. This is not the time for procrastination.

| January 1, 2010 | Some universities have January 1 as the deadline for regular admission applications. |
