

## Guidance Update (March 2, 2010)

### Scholarship Update

**Advantage Credit Union Scholarship**—Advantage Credit Union will award a \$1,000.00 scholarship to a graduating High School Senior. The award is based on student's scholastic and extracurricular activities. **Directions Credit Union Scholarship**—The Directions Credit Union Post Secondary Scholarship consists of two, one time, \$1000.00 scholarships. The scholarship will be paid jointly, to the student and school they attend and applied to their school tuition. The applicant must be a member of Directions Credit Union or have a parent or grandparent that is a member and a graduating high school senior or a current full-time student, attending an accredited college, community college or vocational/trade school. All Directions Credit Union employees, board members and their immediate family members are not eligible to participate. **AAA School Safety Patrol Grant**—Former school safety patrol members can apply for this \$1000 scholarship. Ten grants will be awarded and the scholarship is open to students in a limited number of Ohio Counties. Applications are available on the library counter. Deadline is April 2, 2010.

**NCSC Scholarships**—If you will be going to North Central State College next year, the scholarship deadline is March 12. Applications are on the library counter. Make certain you meet the qualifications.

**Richland County Foundation Scholarships**—You were first alerted to this opportunity on December 11, but the April 1 deadline for receipt of materials is quickly approaching. You must be a Richland county resident and demonstrate financial need. Applications are available on the library counter or at [www.refoundation.org](http://www.refoundation.org).

**Korean War Veterans Association Scholarship**—Two \$1000 scholarships will be awarded for a Richland County graduating senior. A basic qualification requirement is that all applicants must be a direct descendant of a Korean War Era veteran. This does not mean that the Korean War Era veteran had to have served in Korea, but can have served anywhere in the world or in the United States during the period from June 25, 1950 through January 31, 1955. Applications are available from Mr. Grady. Deadline is April 1, 2010.

**ASESIBA Chapter, IAAP Business Scholarship**—Two \$500 scholarships will be awarded to a high school senior who intends to further their education in the business field. Application packets are available on the library counter. Deadline is March 31, 2010.
