SCHOLARSHIP UPDATE (12)

JAMES KURA MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP COMPETITION

This \$1,000 scholarship, sponsored by the Ohio Association of Criminal Defense Lawyers is open to Ohio seniors with a GPA of 2.5 or higher, who have been accepted by an accredited 4 year school beginning in the 2005/2006 academic year. An essay on a pre-selected topic is required. Applications and information are available in the guidance office. Deadline is April 15, 2005.

OHIO ASSOCIATION OF LITTER PREVENTION AND RECYCLING PROFESSIONAL SCHOLARSHIP, C.R. MEYERS MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

OALPRP is a statewide organization that promotes recycling and litter prevention. This scholarship is open to any individual who will be enrolled or is presently enrolled at an accredited Ohio college, university or technical school. The student must be enrolled in a major relating to natural resource conservation, environmental sciences and/or environmental education. The amount of the scholarship is \$1,000. LEXINGTON-SHELBY ELKS LODGE SCHOLARSHIP

One boy and one girl will receive a grant of \$1,000 for those graduating seniors planning to attend a trade school or two or four year college. MKC INVESTING IN OUR FUTURE SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

This scholarship is funded by MKC Associates, Inc. for students graduating from MKC client school districts (of which Shelby is one). Students must intend to major in Architecture; or Mechanical, Electrical, Civil, or Structural Engineering; or Education. The \$500 award is payable directly to an accredited college or university in the student's name to be applied to tuition. An individual statement and a career choice essay are required. Applications are available in the guidance office. Application must be received by MKC by April 1, 2005.

HRH FAMILY FOUNDATIONS SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

This program was established to benefit communities in which the Horvitz family newspapers were located. Richland County is one of a limited number of counties from which students can apply for this scholarship. The amount of a Harry R. Horvitz Scholarship can be as much as \$7,500 per year and is renewable. NORTH CENTRAL STATE COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITIES

NCSC offers several scholarships for NCSC students. The President's Scholarship and Tech Prep Scholarship will pay for 12 credit hours per quarter for three years or until an associate's degree is completed. The Academic Dean's Scholarship will cover six credit hours per quarter up to a maximum of 48 hours. All of these scholarships are considered "last dollar" funds, which mean that each student must apply for federal and state aid by filing a FAFSA.
