HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS NEEDED FOR VOLUNTEER TUTORING PROGRAM (9,10,11,12)

This is a great opportunity to gain volunteer hours for experience, resumes or altruism. High school students agree to volunteer one hour, once per week for seven weeks (June 19th through July 31st) tutoring elementary and middle school students in math and/or reading. All tutoring will be done at the Shelby YMCA. The Shelby YMCA will provide the student volunteer with a summer youth membership. If the student volunteer works the entire program, the youth membership will be extended for a full year. Students must be competent in the subject in which they are tutoring and must be approved by Mr. Grady or Mrs. Dixon. Volunteer forms are available in the guidance office.
