Seniors assigned to 1st or 4th block Study Hall may be excused if their parents agree. To be excused, each senior must have his/her parent or guardian sign the form below and return it to the Attendance Office. Also, each senior must agree to abide by the following guidelines:

1. Excused seniors must leave the building and school grounds on/or about 1:10 pm. Do not return before 2:25 pm.
2. Seniors excused first block are responsible for arriving in time for their 2nd block class.
3. Excused seniors must not visit the Middle School, all elementary schools or Pioneer Career and Technology Center during the released time.
4. If on occasion it is necessary for you to stay the last block, you may, by checking at the attendance office or your regular study hall.
5. Those seniors in study hall have been randomly selected by the computer. Seniors who have a class will not be allowed to change that class.

However, I would remind you that your scholastic achievement and your personal safety are of the utmost importance.
