

THE BRETHERN CARE VILLAGE SCHOLARSHIP 2019

INFORMATION:

The Brethren Care Village Scholarship Fund was established to provide annual scholarships to local graduating high school seniors and has been established by the Brethren Care Village Human Resources Department. The Fund is accepting applications for the 2019 scholarship year. This year we will be awarding **three**, \$1,000 scholarship to eligible graduating seniors at a local high school.

The selection of the three recipients will be made by the Brethren Care Village Scholarship Committee. They will choose five finalists from the applications and each finalist will be contacted for a short interview.

The student selected will be announced at the school's senior awards program. Actual disbursement of the money will be made upon formal enrollment in a recognized institution offering a post-high school curriculum. Money will be awarded in the form of a check and made out to the institution.

ELIGIBILITY:

1. The applicant must be a high school senior currently attending and scheduled to graduate from an area local school in June, 2019.
2. The applicant must have an affiliation (connection) with BCV; family member living or has lived at BCV, have a parent, grandparent or legal guardian employed or volunteering at Brethren Care.
3. The award must be used to further the student's post-high school education at a recognized institution offering a post-high curriculum, such as college or university, technical school, or specialty training school.
4. Applicants must have a minimum 3.0 GPA. Scholarship Achievement, Leadership Abilities, Extracurricular Activities, Community Service and an Essay will be considered in selecting the recipient of the award.
5. There shall be no discrimination in the selection of the recipient based on gender, race, or religion.

INSTRUCTIONS:

Each applicant should pay close attention to the following instructions:

1. Give detailed and explicit answers to all items on the student application form.
2. Turn in completed application form and attachments to **Attn: HR at 2140 Center St., Ashland, OH 44805 by March 29, 2019.**
3. Attach two recommendations from teachers, and one by an adult outside of your family who is acquainted with you through a non-school activity. These recommendations must be included in the completed application packet. Please be sure that you use your 4 digit code in the body of all letters of recommendation – ***no names please.***
4. Please keep the first page of the application separate from the question and answer pages. Also, be sure to provide your 4 digit code at the top of each page where indicated. It is very important that you black out ***any*** reference to your name on your transcripts.
5. Completed applications must be received by 5:00 pm on Friday, March 29, 2019. Your application will be due in the guidance office before that time so that your counselor has time to collect and deliver all applications by the deadline.
6. Any applications received after this date and time will not be considered.
7. Incomplete applications will not be accepted.
